The Tradition of Visio Divina Images as Prayer

A Brief Introduction to Visio Divina¹

Overview

Visio Divina is known as a form of "reading" the Word of God.

- It is not just appreciating the beauty of art and the sentimentality of images
- It opens us up to the Scriptures in vivid new ways

Visio Divina Basic Process: (flexibly adapt the following process, as needed, for individuals and groups)

- 1. Reading (lectio) listening to God's Word in the sacred image; letting God's Word or a particular Scripture passage to approach your heart.
 - What does this biblical image, in itself, really say?
- 2. Meditation (meditatio) ruminating on the Word allow the Word to dwell within you.
 - What is God saying to me/us through this image?
- 3. Prayer (oratio) ask God to open the eyes of your heart and then give this vision back to God.
 - What do I/we say to God in response to this image?
- 4. Contemplation (contemplatio) notice the presence of God stirring within you.
 - How does this image make me/us feel in my/our relationship with God?
- 5. Action (actio) letting the encounter concretely affect our daily life and work in the world
 - How will I/we change what I/we do today in response to listening to God's Word?

- GAZE: ACCENTUATE FACULTIES
 - Be still in mind and body.
 - Trust that God will illuminate your mind
 - o Light a candle, ring a bell or chime, kiss the Scripture, or preform some action that calls you to focus
 - Tame your sentiments and your emotions
 - o "Read" the image with the light of the mind
 - Use your heart, imagination, will and desires
 - Notice the emotion present in the scene, the colors and the symbols
- 2. LISTEN: SEARCH FOR THE TRUTH
 - Find the artist's intentions
 - Identify the expressions of Christ's teachings
 - Identify traditional Catholic symbols and their meanings
- 3. RESPOND: MIRRORING THE INCARNATION
 - o Allow God's presence to transform your life
 - o Identify what ways you desire to live more freely and fully
 - Identify how you will accomplish this desire today
